

Cleaning Codes

Edgecombe Furniture's fabrics are identified with cleaning codes. These codes are listed on the fabric swatch. If you are unaware of the fabric code please contact your representative.

S - To prevent overall soiling, frequent vacuuming or light brushing to remove dust and grime is recommended. Spot clean, using a mild water-free solvent or dry cleaning product. Pretest a small area before proceeding.

W - To prevent overall soiling, frequent vacuuming or light brushing to remove dust and grime is recommended. Spot clean, using the foam only from a water-based cleaning agent such as a mild detergent or non-solvent upholstery shampoo product. Apply foam with a soft brush in a circular motion. Vacuum when dry. Pretest a small area before proceeding.

SW - To prevent overall soiling, frequent vacuuming or light brushing to remove dust and grime is recommended. Spot clean with a mild solvent and upholstery shampoo, or the foam from a mild detergent. When using a solvent or dry cleaning product, follow instructions carefully and clean only in a well - ventilated room.

WS - Spot clean with upholstery shampoo, foam from a mild detergent, or mild dry cleaning solvent. Pre-test a small area before proceeding. Do not saturate. Pile fabrics may require brushing with a non-metallic, stiff bristle brush to restore appearance. Hot water extraction or steam cleaning is not a recommended cleaning method. Cushion casings should not be removed and laundered or dry-cleaned. To prevent overall soiling, frequent vacuuming or light brushing to remove dust and grime is recommended. When cleaning a spill, blot immediately to remove spilled material. Clean spots or stains from the outside to the middle of the affected area to prevent circling.

X - Clean this fabric only by vacuuming or light brushing to prevent accumulation of dust or grime. Water based foam cleaners are solvent-based cleaning agents of any kind may cause excessive shrinking.

CAUTION: Never remove the cushion covers for separate cleaning and washing even though they have zippers. Do not use any tumble method of cleaning service as this may destroy the backing of the fabric and shrink otherwise damaging the upholstery fabric.
